**ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:** The Group Violence Intervention (GVI) Director is responsible for providing day to day coordination and management to support the GVI program, and will work with a team of other project partners including but not limited to: social services agencies, faith-based community organizations, law enforcement, city officials, educational institutes and community members.
